

Rules for visiting the streetball court at New Holland Island

1. The current Rules (hereinafter – “Rules”) for visiting a streetball court (hereinafter – “Court”) located on the territory of New Holland Island (hereinafter – “Island”) are mandatory for all visitors of the Court, regardless of their age and health (hereinafter – “Visitors”).
2. Entry to the Court is a confirmation of the Visitor’s consent to abide to the current Rules.
3. This Court is designed for streetball.
4. Entry to the Court is allowed in sports shoes only (no heels are allowed).
5. In order to avoid a possible injury, it is not recommended that the Court is visited by persons whose physical condition is weakened or by persons with chronic diseases.
6. ANO NEW HOLLAND (hereinafter – “Administration”) is not liable for any harm related to health, including exacerbation of injuries or chronic diseases, or injuries caused by the Visitor him/herself or by third parties.
7. The Administration is not responsible for any harm caused to the health and/or property of the Visitor through unlawful actions of third parties or other visitors.
8. It is not advisable to leave personal belongings unattended when visiting the Court. The Administration is not responsible for unattended belongings.
9. Visitors are forbidden:
 - to eat on the Court;
 - use glassware for drinks on any part of the Court (only plastic or metal glasses and bottles can be used);
 - to be in a state of alcoholic or drug intoxication on the territory of the Court;
 - to drink alcohol-containing beverages on the territory of the Court;
 - to enter the Court with prams, as well as bicycles, scooters, rollers and other transport;
 - to litter the territory of the Court with rubbish, food and household waste, to spill any liquids, to change or worsen the appearance of the Court by applying any inscriptions/images, as well as to cause damage to the coating and/or inventory of the Court;
 - to use sports equipment located on the territory of the Court for any purpose other than intended;
 - to create conflicts on the territory of the Court, to use obscene language, to insulting or attack other persons.
10. The Visitor is responsible for any damage done to the elements of the Court and the sports equipment of the Court.
11. Visitors are required to comply with the following safety requirements of the Court:
 - it is strictly forbidden to climb on the basketball stand/ring, as well as to hang or pull up on it;
 - It is forbidden to twist or loosen compounds of the basketball stand and other elements of the Court, to stick fingers and other body parts in the grooves and cavities of the basketball stand, as well as other technical elements of the Court.
12. In the event of a violation of the Rules by the Visitor, the Administration’s staff, who maintain order on the Island and the Court, have the right to remove the offender from the Court and to apply other means of force under the current legislation.
